#### Stave 1

- 1. On page 34, Dickens uses a long, extended metaphor about "cold" to introduce the reader to the character of Ebenezer Scrooge. What parts of Scrooge's appearance are "cold"? How is his personality "cold"?
- 2. On page 35, you first meet Scrooge's nephew, Fred. How does Dickens immediately describe Fred in a "warm" way that contrasts with the "cold" description of Scrooge? Reading further, how else is Fred presented as a foil (or opposite) for Scrooge in this scene?
- 3. What do Marley's chains represent? Explain why Marley and the other spirits must wander the earth and what ultimate "misery" they suffer as they do.

## Stave 2

The Ghost of Christmas Past takes Scrooge to revisit several scenes of Christmas.

- 4. Describe (in 3-4 sentences) the first Christmas scene when Scrooge was a child all alone. Then, explain what it causes Scrooge to regret and why.
- 5. Describe (in 3-4 sentences) the Christmas at Fezziwig's. Then, explain what it causes Scrooge to regret and why.
- 6. In yet another Christmas past, you learn that Scrooge had once been engaged to a young woman. Why does she break off the engagement? How does this breakup eventually lead to the final regret that Scrooge has about his past?
