Title & Introduction (10 pts)	2 1 <u>Creative Title & Hook</u> : broad, grab the reader’s attention 2 1 <u>Background</u> : general info about the topic 2 1 <u>Narrowing</u> : transition from background to thesis 2 1 <u>Thesis</u> : last sentence, clear topic, arguable opinion 2 1 Overall the intro arouses reader’s curiosity and conveys the right tone about the topic																											
Conclusion (10 pts)	2 1 <u>Restated thesis</u> : first sentence, not repetitive, told in a “conclusive” way 2 1 <u>Argument Summary</u> : remind of the essay’s strongest points, answers “So what?” 2 1 <u>Application</u> : leaves reader with a final impression or take-away 2 1 <u>Clincher</u> : final sentence, reflects the hook, wraps up essay 2 1 Overall the conclusion brings a sense of closure and resolution to the topic

Formatting & Quotes (12 pts)	2 1 <u>MLA Formatting</u> : 1-in. margins, double-spaced, Times New Roman 12-pt, header, etc. 3 2 1 <u>Quotes</u> : Properly blended and punctuated. No block quotes (less than 4 lines each) 2 1 <u>In-Text Citations</u> : all have a corresponding works cited entry; properly formatted 3 2 1 <u>Works Cited Page</u> : fully updated and corrected from first draft 2 1 <u>Sources</u> : minimum 4, at least 2 books, all cited at least once in the essay.																											
Submission & Length	–5% <u>Submission</u> : Parent signature on checklist & all required elements in folder. –10% <u>Length</u> : Minimum 4 FULL pages; Maximum 7 pages (not including works cited). –10% <u>Turnitin</u> : Automatic deduction for late upload.
